- There are no shots, no drilling and no pain.

Oral health services provided at no cost include:

- Dental screening
- Dental cleaning with brushing instruction
- Dental sealants
- Fluoride treatment
- Temporary fillings
- Silver diamine fluoride (stops cavity progression)
- Toothbrush, toothpaste and take-home report for parents

No services are provided without parent/guardian permission and signature.
